Waste Reduction Measures:

- Hot composter installed at the café to allow for compost creation from coffee grounds, cardboard and food waste.
- Local growing collaboration developed with St. Lukes Community Garden volunteers.
- Tiered planter added to the terrace to grow produce when seedlings are transferred from St. Lukes Community Garden.
- Compost and liquid fertiliser from hot composter used to feed the produce grown on the terrace.

Energy Reductions Measures:

- Spotlights updated to LED (50% more efficient)
- Energy efficient dishwasher installed (25% more efficient)
- Follow on energy efficiency grant secured

Future Plans:

- Increasing composting capacity.
- Increasing produce quantities grown.
